

Enter your User ID and password that you have been provided. Press Sign In









A custom guide contains a subset of products from your company's standard guide and from your distributor's master item list. Depending on how your profile is set up, Power Net Customer Portal allows you to create, edit, and delete custom guides.

Create a New Custom Guide

Use this procedure to create, add items to, and delete items from a custom guide.




1. Click Admin, click Custom Guide, and select Create. The Create Custom Guide box displays.





- 2. Enter or select the following:
- Type the name of the new custom guide in the Name field.
- Type the description of the new custom guide in the Description field.
- Select Blank from the Create from drop-down list to begin the new order guide from scratch. This is the default setting.
- Select Custom Category, Class, Family, or Sort from the Set up by drop-down list. The default is Custom Category.
- 3. Click Create. A confirmation message displays.




4. Click Close to exit.


-OR-

Click Edit to work with the new custom guide. The Custom Guide Edit page displays.






5. To create a new custom category, type the custom category name in the New Category field and click Create.



6. The custom category name displays in the Category drop-down list.






7. Continue to the following procedure and use the Add menu to add items to the selected category.

Add Items to a Category

Use this procedure to add items to a custom category from a specific class, category, or family.

1. This procedure begins on the Custom Guide by Custom Category – Edit page.




2. Click Add and select an option to indicate how you want to add items to the new category. Select to add items by Item, Class, Category, or Family. The selected items are added to the custom category. In this example, we selected Class. The Custom Guide by Custom Category – Add Items page displays.




Click to view and select a class of items to display.




3. Click the down arrow to select a group of items and select the item group with the items that you want to choose from to add to the custom category.




- 4. All items included in the selected item group display in the left pane. In this example, the left pane displays all items included in the DRY GOODS class.
- 5. Select the Select check box next to items to add to the custom category and click a green arrow to move the selected items to the selected category.





6. The selected items display in the right section of the page. The items display the name of the assigned category in the left section of the page.







Use Search

Use this procedure to search for an item within a selected list of items. For example, we want to find packets of sweetener in the selected Dry Goods class.

1. Use search on the Custom Guide by Custom Category page when you are adding items to find an item in a selected category.




- 2. Select a search option from the Search Type drop-down list.
- 3. Type a product name or product category in the Search field and click Go.






4. Search results display in the left pane of the Custom Guide Add page.




5. A list of items that meet the search criteria specified displays in the left section.



6. To add an item to the custom category in your custom guide, select the Select check box next to the item and click the green arrows.





- 7. The selected items display on your custom order guide in the section on the right. The Category column displays the name of the category in the left section.
- 8. Click Save to save the custom guide.
- 9. Repeat steps 2 8 to add more items to the custom guide.
- 10. Click Back to return to the Custom Guide by Custom Category Edit page.
